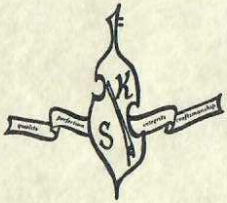

Description

The instrument is a three-quarter size, gamba shaped, flat back model Bass Violin. The top table is a two-piece plate of medium vertical grained spruce. The back table is a two-piece plate of slight figured maple with ribs of matching character maple to that of the back table. The neck and scroll are not original but of a latter period, and are of slightly figured maple. The gears are Rococo tuners. The color of the varnish is a deep, reddish brown. The instrument is in fine condition.
